The Nancy Morris Trophy has been a long standing Award we have presented annually and is named after Nancy Morris, a lady who almost single handedly set the foundation for Bedfordshire County Netball many years ago, with her tireless and forward thinking determination to make netball within Bedfordshire the best.

The Nancy Morris Trophy will be awarded annually to a person who has made a significant and valuable contribution to Bedfordshire Netball at Club, League or County level in a volunteering capacity. Demonstrating the impact that the person has made to the Club, or League or County, showing a willingness to go above and beyond the call of duty, always doing more than is required.

The Sylvia Eastley Trophy is a new Award we have introduced to honour a long standing member of Bedfordshire Netball, Sylvia Eastley. Netball meant so much to Sylvia, especially netball in Bedfordshire. She was involved in both Coaching and Officiating. Her knowledge and expertise were greatly respected both as a Coach and an International Umpire. An exceptional volunteer, Sylvia was so generous with her time and sharing her expertise with all.

This award will be presented annually to a person who has made a significant impact in developing individuals to reach their full potential either as an Umpire or a Coach, by generously giving their time; knowledge and experience.

The Bedfordshire County Netball Long Service Award

The Bedfordshire Long Service Award recognises the contribution of a Volunteer who has used their invaluable experience to give outstanding service for over 15 years or more and has been active during the last 12 months.

To be eligible, nominees must be affiliated to Bedfordshire County Netball, have supported netball development by way of coaching, officiating or administration and have volunteered significantly at a County, League and/or Club level.
