Bedfordshire County Netball Individual Development Fund Criteria

The County has set up the Development Fund to assist individual Members across the County, who wish to enhance their personal skills and knowledge, by offering financial support towards the cost of Coaching and Officiating Courses and/or Workshops fees.

We also acknowledge the need to support Young Athletes who are on the EN Performance Pathway (i.e. NPL or above) to higher level netball and recognise that participation in training and competition at this level can involve high expense. Therefore, it is possible to apply to the County for consideration of some financial support by way of a bursary from the Development Fund.

Bedfordshire County Netball will consider requests for financial assistance taking into consideration the following criteria;

- Applicant to reside in Bedfordshire
- Applicant must be affiliated to EN and Bedfordshire
- Applicant must play for or have an association with a Bedfordshire Club or attend a Bedfordshire School
- Consideration on the future contribution and benefit to the County may be taken into account
- Each request will be considered on its merits and the percentage of funding awarded as appropriate at the Committee's discretion
- There can only be one grant made per individual per season
- A copy of the relevant application form for the course/workshop, etc., and confirmation of acceptance on the course/workshop, should accompany any application for funding
- Applicant must make a specific request and detail how grant/subsidy will be used by completing and returning the County Development Fund Application Form
