Individual Development Fund Criteria

The County has set up the Development Fund to assist individual Members across the county, who wish to enhance their personal skill and knowledge, by offering financial support towards the cost of attending courses, e.g. coaching; officiating or workshops and/or associated compliance workshops.

We also acknowledge the need to support Young Performance Players who are on the Superleague Pathway (i.e. U17 and above) or within the England Netball National Pathway Programme and are striving to develop their performance levels further. We recognise that participation in training and competition at this level can involve high expense. Therefore, it is possible to apply to the County for consideration of some financial support by way of a bursary from the Development Fund.

Bedfordshire County Netball will consider requests for financial assistance taking into consideration the following criteria:

- Applicant must be affiliated to EN with Primary affiliation to Bedfordshire
- Applicant must have an association with a Bedfordshire Club or attend a Bedfordshire School

Other Requirements

- Consideration on the future contribution and benefit to the County may be taken into account
- Each request will be considered on its merits and the percentage of funding awarded as appropriate at the Committee's discretion
- There can only be one grant made per individual per season
- A copy of the relevant application form for the course/workshop, etc., and confirmation of acceptance on the course/workshop, should accompany any application for funding
- Application must make a specific request and detail how grant/subsidy will be used by completing and returning the County Development Fund Application Form to the County Secretary
- Applications for Development Funding will only be considered at County Committee meetings, meeting dates are published on the County calendar on the County website.
